**Keith Kerr** is Professor and Consultant Pathologist at the Aberdeen University Medical School & Aberdeen Royal Infirmary. He was awarded an Honorary Chair in Pulmonary Pathology at the University of Aberdeen in 2006. His research interests include pre-neoplasia and carcinogenesis, lung tumour diagnosis and classification, and the identification of predictors of therapy response.



He is a member of numerous national and international lung cancer clinical advisory and research groups (BTOG steering group, the Pulmonary Pathology Society Council, the ETOP Foundation Council, ESMO Educational Faculty for thoracic tumours and the Board of the IASLC).

Professor Kerr became a member of ESMO in 2012, joined the ESMO Faculty group for lung cancer and other thoracic malignancies as expert pathologist and is a lead author of the ESMO Consensus Guidelines on pathology and molecular biomarkers for non-small-cell lung cancer. He is involved in a number of UK, European and North American initiatives looking at the introduction, operation and quality assurance of guidelines for management of, and molecular pathology testing in, lung cancer.

**Henrik Schmidt** is Associate Professor, Consultant and Head of Clinical Research Unit, Department of Oncology, Aarhus University Hospital, Denmark.

His main research interest is immunotherapy and he has been working with national and international clinical trials in medical treatment of melanoma as well as biomarkers within the innate immune system.



Henrik Schmidt is currently a board member of the Danish National Melanoma Group.
